CM No.1228-CI of 2016

Applicants seek exemption from filing certified copy of the main award dated 04.08.2011 passed by learned Addl. District Judge, Jhajjar.

Application is allowed, as prayed for. Exemption sought is granted.

CM stands disposed of.

CM No.1230-CI of 2016

Applicant seeks leave of the Court to file appeal on behalf of the legal representatives of late Sh. Jaipan son of Nafe Singh-appellant No.2, on the basis of particulars given in para 2 of the application.

After hearing the learned counsel for the applicant, instant application is allowed, for the reasons stated therein, however, subject to all just exceptions. Leave sought is granted.

CM stands disposed of.

CM No.1229-CI of 2016 in/and RFA No.472 of 2016

Applicants seek condonation of delay of 1496 days in filing the appeal.

Learned counsel for the applicants submits that present appeal is squarely covered by the order dated 31.08.2015 passed by this Court in **RFA No.1626 of 2011 (Puran Chand Wadhwa (deceased) through LRs Vs. Land Acquisition Collector and another)**.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Shivendra Swaroop, AAG, Haryana accepts notice and after going through the record, fairly submits that present appeal is covered by the order dated 31.08.2015 passed by this Court in **Puran Chand Wadhwa's** case (supra).

In view of the above, application for condonation of delay is allowed, for the reasons stated therein. Delay of 1496 days in filing the appeal is condoned. However, in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Imrat Lal and others Vs. Land Acquisition Collector and others, 2015 (1) SCC (Civil) 242**, the applicants-appellants shall not be entitled for interest for this period of 1496 days in filing the appeal.

CM stands disposed of.

The appeal having been found squarely covered by the order dated 31.08.2015 passed by this Court in **Puran Chand Wadhwa's** case (supra), it is ordered to be disposed of, in terms of the order dated 31.08.2015 passed by this Court in **RFA No.1626 of 2011 (Puran Chand Wadhwa (deceased) through LRs Vs. Land Acquisition Collector and another)**.

Disposed of, accordingly.
