Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the appellant submits that the matter is squarely covered by the order dated 22.08.2016 passed by this Court in **RFA No.3361 of 2016** titled as **“Thuru Ram and another V/s Union of India and others”**.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent(s)-Union of India does not dispute the aforementioned fact.

Since the matter is covered by the order, aforementioned, I do not intend to keep the matter pending.

For the reasons stated in the application which is duly supported by an affidavit, the application bearing No.13343-CI-2016 is
