CM No.1247-CI of 2016

Applicants seek condonation of delay of 964 days in refiling the appeal.

After hearing the learned counsel for the applicants, instant application is allowed, for the reasons stated therein. Delay of 964 days in refiling the appeal is condoned.

CM No.1248-CI of 2016

Applicants seek condonation of delay of 1080 days in filing the appeal.

After hearing the learned counsel for the applicants, instant application is allowed, for the reasons stated therein. Delay of 1080 days in filing the appeal is condoned. However, in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Imrat Lal and others Vs. Land Acquisition Collector and others, 2015 (1) SCC (Civil) 242**, the applicants-appellants shall not be entitled for interest for this period of 1080 days in filing the appeal.

CM No.1249-CI of 2016

Applicants seek exemption from filing certified copy of the award dated 31.10.2012.

Application is allowed, as prayed for. Exemption sought is granted.
