Allowed as prayed for.

CM No.1479-CI of 2016

For the reasons set out in the application, which is duly supported by an affidavit, the same is allowed. Consequently, the delay in making good the deficiency in Court fee is condoned.

Application is allowed.

CM No.1478-CI of 2016

This is an application for condonation of delay of 426 days in filing the accompanying appeal. All what has been urged by learned counsel for the applicants is that the matter in issue is squarely covered by the judgement, dated 29.09.2015, rendered by this court in RFA No.2463 of

2015 – Kishan and others v. State of Haryana and another, vide which this court had enhanced the compensation awarded to the landowners.

Notice in the application.

On the asking of the court, Mr. Shivendra Swaroop, AAG, Haryana, present in court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

In the wake of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Imrat Lal and others v. Land Acquisition Collector and others, 2015(2) RCR (Civil) 437, delay of 426 days in filing the accompanying appeal is condoned. However, for the period of delay the applicant shall not be entitled to interest on the enhanced compensation.

CM stands disposed of.

For, the learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that the matter in issue is squarely covered by the decision rendered by this court in Kishan and others' case (supra), the present appeal is disposed of in terms of the said decision. However, the appellants shall not be entitled to interest for the period of delay in filing the appeal i.e. 426 days.
