Applicants seek condonation of delay of 3905 days in filing the appeal.

After hearing the learned counsel for the parties, instant application is allowed, for the reasons stated therein. Delay of 3905 days in filing the appeal stands condoned, however, the applicants-appellants shall not be entitled for interest for this period of 3905 days, in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Imrat Lal and others v. Land Acquisition Collector and others, 2015 (2) RCR (Civil) 437.**

CM stands disposed of, accordingly.

Applicants seek leave to file appeal on behalf of legal representatives of Late Sh.Norang Singh, on the basis of particulars given in para 3 of the application.

After hearing the learned counsel for the parties, instant application is allowed, however, subject to all just exceptions. Leave sought is granted.

CM-9030-CI-2014

Applicants seek exemption from filing the certified copies of order and main award.

Application is allowed, as prayed for.

CM stands disposed of.

Main case

Learned counsel for the appellants submits that instant appeal is squarely covered by the judgment dated 12.10.2015 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Civil Appeal No(s). 6515 of 2009 (Haryana State Industrial Development Corporation v. Pran Sukh and others)**.
