However, it is made clear that the applicant-appellants shall not be entitled for interest for this delay of 1020 days, in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Imrat Lal and others Vs. Land Acquisition Collector and others, 2015 (2) RCR (civil) 437.**
