Applicant seeks condonation of delay of 1303 days in filing the
appeal.

On the asking of the court, Sh. Shivendra Swaroop, AAG,

Haryana, accepts notice and fairly states that let the delay of 1303 days be

condoned in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Imrat Lal and others Vs. Land Acquisition Collector and others, 2015 (2) RCR (Civil) 437.**

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, instant application is allowed for the reasons stated therein. Delay of 1303 days in filing the appeal is condoned. However, in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Imrat Lal's case (supra)**, applicant shall not be entitled for interest for the delayed period of 1303 days.
