Applicant seeks condonation of delay of 315 days in re-filing the appeal.

After hearing learned counsel for the applicant, instant application is allowed for the reasons stated therein. Delay of 315 days in re-filing the appeal is condoned.

Applicant seeks condonation of delay of 702 days in filing the appeal.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, instant application is allowed for the reasons stated therein. Delay of 702 days in filing the present appeal is condoned. However, it is made clear that the

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applicant-appellant shall not be entitled for interest for this delay of 702 days, in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Imrat Lal and others Vs. Land Acquisition Collector and others, 2015 (2) RCR (civil) 437.**
