Applicant seeks condonation of delay of 514 days in filing the appeal.

However, in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Imrat Lal and others VS. Land Acquisition Collector and others, 2014 (14) SCC 133**, applicant-appellant shall not be entitled for the interest for this period of 514 days in filing the appeal.
