After arguing for some time and upon a query of this Court as to the stage of proceedings before the learned Civil Judge, after the remand of the suit to that Court, learned counsel admits that the suit is at the stage of consideration for pronouncement of the judgment.

In view of the above, since on remand, the suit is again on the verge of pronouncement and it is seen that there was a technical defect in the issues having been framed much after the evidence was led, learned counsel eventually seeks to withdraw the suit, with liberty to avail of his remedy against the judgment to be pronounced by the Civil Judge and thereafter. Obviously those remedies would in any case be available to the appellant.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
