Notice of the application to counsel for the non-applicants-
respondents.

Sh. Sachin Mittal, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of

respondents No. 2 and 4 to 8. He states that he has got no objection if the application is allowed.

In view of averments made in the application coupled with the statement made by counsel for the non-applicants-respondent Nos. 2 and 4 to 8, the application is allowed, order dated 24.5.2016 is recalled and the appeal is ordered to be restored to its original number and stage.

Counsel for the applicants-respondents has submitted that dispute between the parties has been settled by way of compromise and as per the compromise, the respondents are obligated to pay an amount of Rs. 8 lakhs to the appellant. He has further submitted that four cheques of the value of Rs. 2 lakhs each are being handed over to counsel for the appellant today in the Court. It is prayed that in view of settlement between the parties, the appeal may be disposed of.

Counsel for the non-applicant-appellant has submitted that he has received an amount of Rs. 8 lakhs by way of four cheques but the respondents must ensure that the cheques are encashed on its presentation to

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the bank. He further states that in view of compromise between the parties, the appeal may be dismissed as withdrawn.

In view of the above, the appeal is dismissed as withdrawn. However, the respondents shall ensure that the cheques issued qua payment of Rs. 8 lakhs to the appellant are encashed on its presentation to the bank within the period of validity.
