Instant petition under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure has been filed seeking transfer of Civil suit for damages titled '**Ashok Kumar Vs. Ram Chand Ahuja and others**', filed by respondent-husband from the Court at Tehsil Samana, District Patiala to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Tehsil Rajpura, District Patiala.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

Learned counsel for the applicant contended that respondent has filed a civil suit for damages, which is pending in the Court of learned Civil Judge (Jr. Division), Samana, District Patiala. Now

applicant is residing with her parents at Rajpura, District Patiala.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondent does not oppose the application, however requests that the civil suit for damages may be transferred to Patiala which is in between Samana and Rajpura and it will be convenient for both the parties to attend proceedings there.

Learned counsel for the applicant states that the applicant has no objection if the civil suit for damages is transferred to Patiala.

In view of consent of both the sides, civil suit for damages pending in the Court of learned Civil Judge (Jr. Division), Samana, District Patiala is withdrawn and ordered to be transferred to learned District Judge, Patiala, who may assign the same to the Court of competent jurisdiction there. Learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Samana, shall ensure that entire record of the case is sent to learned District Judge, Patiala. The parties are directed to appear before the learned District Judge, Patiala on 04.03.2016.
