PARAMJEET SINGH DHALIWAL, J. (ORAL)

Instant petition under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure has been filed seeking transfer of Civil suit for permanent injunction titled '**Kuljit Singh and another Vs. Kaushalya Devi and others**', filed by respondents-plaintiffs from the Court at Ferozepur to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Chandigarh.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

I need not go into the facts and arguments of the learned counsel in detail, as during arguments, learned counsel for the parties

have consented that the civil suit in question may be transferred to Chandigarh.

In view of consent of both the sides, civil suit for permanent injunction pending in the Court of learned Civil Judge (Jr. Division), Ferozepur is withdrawn and ordered to be transferred to learned District Judge, Chandigarh, who may assign the same to the Court of competent jurisdiction there. Learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Ferozepur, shall ensure that entire record of the case is sent to learned District Judge, Chandigarh. The parties are directed to appear before the learned District Judge, Chandigarh on 14.03.2016.
