Learned counsel for the appellant submits that since the appellants were not able to prove their possession of the suit property, their suit seeking permanent injunction against the respondents, was dismissed.

He submits that he may be permitted to withdraw this appeal with liberty to avail of his appropriate remedy.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, even while granting the liberty as aforesaid, it is made clear that nothing whatsoever is being said by this Court on the merits of the case of the appellants, including the maintainability of any subsequent suit to be filed by them. As such, if a suit seeking any relief is filed by the appellants, it would be decided entirely on its own merits, on all issues involved.
