In this appeal, CM No.16322-23-C-2016 has been filed for referring the appeal to the Lok Adalat for settlement. But the application shows that the compromise between the parties has already taken place before the Executing Court and even on the basis of said compromise the execution has been satisfied.

In these circumstances, when the compromise has already been affected between the parties, there remains nothing to be referred to the Lok Adalat.

Learned counsel for the appellant states that he has received the telephonic instructions from the appellant for withdrawal of the present appeal. He also states that the main appeal should be taken up today itself and the same may be dismissed as withdrawn.
