

## SONIA AND ANR V/S STATE OF HARYANA AND ORS

Present : None for the petitioner (s).

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On the last date of hearing, none caused representation on behalf of the petitioners. Today as well, none has caused appearance despite information to the counsel.

On 13.06.2013, following order was passed by this Court:-

*“This is a petition seeking protection of life and liberty of the petitioners from respondents no.4 to 6.*

*On 07.06.2013, the following order was passed by this Court:*

*“Instant petition has been filed seeking protection of life and liberty of the petitioners from respondents no.4 to 6. The petitioners assert that they are major and as there is no legal impediment, they have got married. They have already moved representation dated 06.06.2013 (Annexure P-4) to respondent no.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar, for protecting their life and liberty.*

*Learned counsel for the petitioners, after seeking instructions from petitioner no.2 states that in order to show his bona fide, petitioner no.2 will deposit a sum of Rs.50,000 in the form of FDR for three years in favour of petitioner no.1 by adjourned date and another sum of Rs.50,000/- within ten months thereafter. An affidavit of petitioner no.2 dated 07.06.2013 to the above effect has been filed in Court which is taken on record.*

*Notice of motion for 13.06.2013.*

*In the meantime, liberty is granted to the petitioners to approach respondent no.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar, for protection as per instructions dated 21.02.2011 issued by the Home Department, Haryana. Petitioners may not be arrested and adequate*

*security be provided to them, if required.”*

*Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in compliance of order dated 07.06.2013, petitioner no.2 has deposited the amount of Rs.50,000/- in the form of FDR for three years in favour of petitioner no.1 and will deposit the remaining amount of Rs.50,000/- in the form of FDR for three years in favour of petitioner no.1 within ten months. A photocopy of receipt, filed in Court, is taken on record.*

*Keeping in view the above, the order dated 07.06.2013 is made absolute.*

*Petitioner no.1 will intimate this Court about deposit of remaining amount of Rs.50,000/- by petitioner no.2 as aforesaid along with a photocopy of the FDR.*

*Disposed of.”*

Neither the parties are coming forward, nor the counsel has come present. It appears that the parties have lost interest in the matter.

Accordingly, the matter is disposed of with liberty to the aggrieved party to revive the same within six weeks from today.
