AMIT RAWAL, J. (ORAL)

Mr. Sunil Chadha, learned Senior Counsel assisted by Mr. Chetan Bansal, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent(s)-plaintiff(s) submits that this Court vide order dated 13.01.2016 sent the matter to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. The appellants in the present regular second appeal are the defendants in a suit bearing No.273 of 2008 for recovery of ₹ 39,60,000/-.

As per the report of the Mediator, the matter has been compromised and the settlement/agreement dated 17.02.2016 is placed on record. The sale deed in respect of the suit property has been executed in favour of the respondent(s)-plaintiff(s) and the amount which the respondent(s)-plaintiff(s) had to pay to the appellant(s)-defendant(s), has also been paid and accordingly, the grievance of the appellant(s)-

defendant(s) and as well as the respondent(s)-plaintiff(s) stands redressed.

He further submits that for recovering the aforementioned amount, twice he had paid the huge amount of Courts fee before the trial Court and against the dismissal of the suit again before the lower Appellate Court and prays for refund of the same.

In view of the fact that the matter has been compromised, the respondent(s)-plaintiff(s) shall entitled to refund of the Courts fee of ₹ 93,450/- stated to be paid before the lower Appellate Court subject to the permissible deductions.

With the aforesaid observations, the appeal stands disposed of.
