Petitioner-wife, by way of instant petition under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, seeks transfer of a petition filed by the respondent-husband under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, ('the HM Act' for short) from Amritsar to a competent court at Fatehgarh Sahib.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned counsel for the respondent has fairly conceded that he has got instructions to say that the respondent is not averse to the transfer of his petition from Amritsar to Fatehgarh Sahib.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. Petition under Section 13 of the HM Act filed by the respondent-husband is ordered to be transferred from Amritsar to Fatehgarh Sahib.

Accordingly, learned District Judge, Amritsar, is directed to send the complete record of the above-said case to the learned District Judge, Fatehgarh Sahib at an early date and in any case within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Learned District Judge, Fatehgarh Sahib is also directed to either decide the case himself or assign it to the learned court of competent jurisdiction for its early decision, in accordance with law.

With the above-said observations made and directions issued, the present petition stands disposed of.
