This is an application under Section 24 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure seeking transfer of proceedings initiated by the respondent-husband under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short 'the Act') at Assandh.

It is urged before the court that certain proceedings are already pending at Panipat. Besides, no maintenance is being paid to the applicant and she is facing financial hardship as she has no source of income. It would not be possible for her to defend the proceedings at Assandh.

Keeping in view the aforesaid contentions and facts and circumstances of the case, it is directed the proceedings initiated by the respondent under Section 9 of the Act be transferred from Assandh to a court of co-ordinate jurisdiction at Panipat.

The present petition is allowed in these terms.
