Instant application under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure has been filed seeking transfer of petition titled as 'Vikas Sachdeva vs. Monika Sachdeva etc.' under Section 25 of the Guardian and Wards Act, 1890 (for short, 'the Act') filed by the respondent-husband for the custody of minors-Shivam and Diya, from Sonapat to Ambala.

Upon notice, the respondent put in appearance through his counsel. Learned counsel for the respondent states that he has no

objection if the case filed by respondent-husband under Section 25 of the Act is transferred to Ambala.

Without going into the merits of the case and in view of law laid down in *Deepti Bhandari vs. Nitin Bhandari and another 2012(1) R.C.R. (Civil) 506*, application is allowed. Petition under Section 25 of the Act pending in the Court of learned Family Court, Sonapat is ordered to be transferred to learned District Judge, Ambala, who may assign the same to the Court of competent jurisdiction there. Learned District Judge, Family Court, Sonapat shall ensure that entire record of the case is sent to learned District Judge, Ambala. The parties through their counsel are directed to appear before the learned District Judge, Ambala on 17.02.2016.
