Applicant-wife, by way of instant transfer application under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, seeks transfer of a divorce petition filed by the respondent-husband from Amritsar to Barnala.

Notice of motion was issued in this case on 21.03.2016. Thereafter, matter came up for hearing before the learned matrimonial Court at Amritsar on 17.05.2016 but the applicant did not appear and has been proceeded against ex-parte vide order dated 17.05.2016 passed by the learned matrimonial Court at Amritsar.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the applicant seeks permission to withdraw the instant transfer application with liberty to the applicant to move appropriate application before the learned matrimonial Court at Amritsar, seeking set aside the abovesaid ex-parte order dated 17.05.2016 and thereafter, may file a similar transfer application before this Court, as and when necessity arises.

Permission is granted.
