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**RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (ORAL)**

Applicant-wife, by way of instant application under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, seeks transfer of a petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short 'the Act') filed by the respondent-husband from Yamuna Nagar to Rajpura, District Patiala.

Notice of motion was issued and in the meantime, further proceedings before the learned trial Court at Yamuna Nagar were stayed.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the parties have agreed that instead of transferring petition under Section 9 of the HM Act from Yamuna Nagar to Rajpura, let the same be transferred to Ambala.

In view of the abovesaid undisputed fact situation obtaining in

the present case, instant transfer application is allowed. Petition under Section 9 of the Act bearing HMA case No.19 of 2016 titled as Manoj Taneja Vs. Sharda @ Shelly filed by the respondent-husband, is ordered to be transferred from Yamuna Nagar to Ambala.

Accordingly, learned District Judge, Yamuna Nagar is directed to send the complete record of the abovesaid petition, to the learned District Judge, Ambala at an early date and in any case within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Learned District Judge, Ambala is also directed either to decide the case himself or assign it to the learned Court of competent jurisdiction for its early decision, in accordance with law.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, instant transfer application stands disposed of, however, with no order as to costs.
