Rajan Gupta, J.

Petitioner, who is wife of respondent, seeks transfer of proceedings under section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act pending at Jind to Panipat. It is urged that respondent-husband is employed in police department and she has financial constraints. It would be difficult for her to defend the proceedings at Jind. She also has a minor daughter to look after.

Prayer has been opposed by counsel representing the respondent-husband. According to him, respondent-husband would be unnecessarily harassed by travelling to Panipat.

However, keeping in view the fact that petitioner is a woman and has a minor daughter, she may find it difficult to effectively defend proceedings at Jind. Admittedly, distance between the place where she is living and Jind city is much lesser.

In the facts and circumstances, it is directed that the

proceedings under section 13 of the Act pending at Jind be transferred to competent court at Panipat.

Allowed in the above terms.
