Rajan Gupta, J.

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Petitioner, who is wife of respondent, seeks transfer of proceedings under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short 'the Act'), pending at Panipat to Jind. It is urged before the court that petitioner initiated proceedings under Section 125 of the Code of Criminal Procedure at Jind. Besides, certain litigation is pending at Jind. It is further submitted that petitioner is residing with her parents along with her two minor children. She is facing financial hardship and it is very difficult for her to defend the case at Panipat as the distance from Panipat to Jind is 70 Kms.

Keeping in view facts and circumstances of the case, it is directed that the proceedings under Section 13 of the Act pending at Panipat be transferred to competent court at Jind.
