Petitioner, who is wife of respondent, seeks transfer of proceedings under Section 13 (1) (ia) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short 'the Act'), pending at Rewari to Sonipat. It is urged before the court that petitioner initiated the proceedings under Section 125 of the Code of Criminal Procedure at Sonipat. It is further submitted that petitioner is residing with her parents along with two minor children at Sonipat. Besides, she has no source of income and it is very difficult for her to defend the case at Rewari as the distance from Rewari to Sonipat is 120 KMs.

Keeping in view facts and circumstances of the case, it is directed that the proceedings under Section 13 (1) (ia) of the Act pending at Rewari be transferred to competent court at Sonipat.
