This is a petition under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure seeking transfer of proceedings initiated by the respondent-husband under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act (for short 'the Act') at Patiala.

It is urged before the court that proceedings initiated by the applicant under Section 13 of the Act are already pending at Sangrur. According to learned counsel, applicant is unemployed and is facing financial hardship. It would not be possible for her to defend the proceedings at Patiala.

Keeping in view the aforesaid contentions and facts and circumstances of the case, it is directed the proceedings initiated by the respondent under Section 9 of the Act be transferred from Patiala to a court of co-ordinate jurisdiction at Sangrur.

The present petition is allowed in these terms.
