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This is a petition under Section 24 of the Civil Procedure Code for transfer of petition under Section 13(1a) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short 'the Act') from Rupnagar to Ludhiana.

Petitioner has filed a divorce petition at Ludhiana (Annexure P-1) under Section 13 of the Act in which notice was issued to respondent-husband. Respondent-husband also preferred a divorce petition under Section 13 of the Act at Rupnagar (Annexure P-2).

According to learned counsel for respondent, compromise has already been effected between the parties. It is submitted that petition filed at Ludhiana can be converted into proceedings under Section 13-B of the Act.

Under the circumstance, petition under Section 13 of the Act, pending at Rupnagar is directed to be transferred to the competent court at Ludhiana, where the petition under Section 13 of the Act filed by petitioner-wife is pending. The court shall consider whether such petition can be converted into Section 13-B of the Act and proceed further as per law.
