It is further submitted that petitioner is residing with her parents and distance from Ropar to Patiala is 75 KMs. Besides, petitioner is facing financial hardship in defending the case at Patiala.

Respondent remains un-represented despite service.

Keeping in view facts and circumstances of the case, it is directed that the proceedings under Section 13 of the Act pending at Patiala be transferred to competent court at Ropar.
