Petitioner, who is wife of respondent, seeks transfer of proceedings filed under Section 13(1) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short 'the Act') at Kapurthala to Hoshiarpur. It is urged before the court that petitioner is residing with her parents having one minor child who is suffering from brain tumour. Besides, petitioner is facing financial hardship in defending the case at Kapurthala.

According to report received from Registry, respondent refused to accept summons sent by the court. Respondent remains unrepresented.

Keeping in view facts and circumstances of the case, it is directed that the proceedings under Section 13(1) of the Act pending at Kapurthala be transferred to competent court at Hoshiarpur.
