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This is a petition seeking transfer of proceedings initiated by husband-respondent under Section 13 (1) (i-a) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short 'the Act') from the court at Panipat to Sonapat. It is urged before the court that certain litigation are pending at Sonapat. Petitioner is dependent on her parents and she has no source of income.

Respondent is stated to be a property dealer at Panipat.

Keeping in view aforesaid contentions, facts and circumstances of the case, it is directed that proceedings under Section 13 (1) (i-a) of the Act be transferred from Panipat to the court of coordinate jurisdiction at Sonapat.
