This is an application under section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure seeking transfer of proceedings initiated by the husband under section 13 of the Act from the court at Moga to Nawanshahr. It is urged before this court that petitioner is a lady and has no financial resources. Besides, she has a minor child to look after.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondent has opposed the prayer for transfer of the case to Nawanshahr. He, however, submits that the case may be transferred to any other District.

Keeping in view facts that petitioner is unemployed and has a minor child to look after, this court feels that it will be difficult for the petitioner to defend the proceedings at Moga. In view of the facts and circumstances of the case as well as objection raised by the respondent husband, this court feels that it will be just and fair if the proceedings are transferred to a court of coordinate jurisdiction at Ropar. Ordered accordingly.
