Petitioner seeks transfer of proceedings initiated by respondent husband under section 13 of the Act from Sangrur to Barnala.

Admittedly, petitioner has already appeared before the court at Sangrur and engaged a counsel to represent her. Trial of the case has made some headway. It is now fixed for evidence of the respondent-husband. Besides, distance between Sangrur and Barnala is not much. Under the circumstances, no case for transfer of proceedings is made out. However, respondent shall be liable to pay Rs.4000/- as litigation/travelling expenses to the petitioner on the date she appears before the court to depose as a witness.
