Petitioner, who is wife of respondent, seeks transfer of proceedings under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short 'the Act') pending at Panipat to Jind. It is urged before the court that petitioner initiated the proceedings under Section 125 of the Code of Criminal Procedure against respondent, which is pending at Jind. It is further stated certain litigation are also pending at Jind. It is urged before the court that petitioner is unemployed and has no source of income. She is residing at Jind with her relations as her parents have also expired. It would be difficult for her to defend the proceedings at Panipat. Respondent remains unrepresented despite service.

Keeping in view facts and circumstances of the case, it is directed that the proceedings under Section 9 of the Act pending at Panipat be transferred to competent court at Jind.
