Petitioner, who is wife of respondent, seeks transfer of proceedings under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short the 'Act') pending at Ambala to Jagadhri. It is urged before the court that petitioner-wife filed a petition under Section 125 of the Criminal Procedure Code in the court of Yamunanagar at Jagadhri against respondent. Besides, petitioner is totally dependent on her parents and has no source of income. It is further submitted that it would be difficult for her to defend the proceedings at Ambala.

Respondent remains un-represented despite service.

Keeping in view facts and circumstances of the case, it is directed that the proceedings under Section 13 of the Act pending at Ambala be transferred to competent court at Jagadhri.
