It is urged before the court that petitioner initiated the proceedings under Section 125 of the Code of Criminal Procedure and under Section 12 of the Domestic Violence Act. It is further submitted that petitioner is residing at Gurgaon with her parents and facing financial hardship in defending the case at Rohtak as the distance from Rohtak to Gurgaon is 90 KMs.
