Petitioner, who is wife of respondent, seeks transfer of proceedings under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short 'the Act'), pending at Ludhiana to Jalandhar. It is urged before the court that petitioner is dependent on her parents. Besides, certain litigation are pending at Jalandhar. She has no source of income and it is very difficult for her to defend the case at Ludhiana as the distance from Ludhiana to Jalandhar is 60 KMs.

Respondent remains un-represented despite service.

Keeping in view facts and circumstances of the case, it is directed that the proceedings under Section 9 of the Act pending at Ludhiana be transferred to competent court at Jalandhar.
