Petitioner, who is wife of respondent, seeks transfer of proceedings under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short 'the Act'), pending at Moga to Ludhiana. It is urged before the court that petitioner is dependent on her parents. Besides certain litigation is pending at Ludhiana. She has financial constraints and has one year old child to look after. It is very difficult for her to defend the case at Moga.

Respondent remains un-represented despite service.

Keeping in view facts and circumstances of the case, it is directed that the proceedings under Section 9 of the Act pending at Moga be transferred to competent court at Ludhiana.
