Applicant, by way of instant application under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, seeks transfer of Civil Suit No.390 dated 01.09.2008 titled as State Bank of Bikaner & Jaipur, Branch Mandi Gobindgarh Vs. Ramesh Kaur and others from Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib to the learned Court of competent jurisdiction at Khanna, District Ludhiana.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned counsel for the contesting respondent No.2 appears and fairly states that he has no objection in case the instant application is allowed. However, nobody has put appearance on behalf of respondent No.1-Bank, despite its service through Sh. Kewal Krishan Garg, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State Bank of Bikaner & Jaipur in its civil suit at Amloh.

Learned counsel for the applicant and respondent No.2 are ad idem that other civil suits of similar nature are pending consideration before the learned Court of competent jurisdiction at Khanna, District Ludhiana, as per Annexures P-2 & P-3. In this view of the matter, it would not only be convenient to all the parties concerned but also in the interest of justice to transfer the abovesaid recovery suit from Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib to Khanna, District Ludhiana.

Accordingly, learned District Judge, Fatehgarh Sahib is directed to send the complete record of Civil Suit No.390 dated 01.09.2008 titled as State Bank of Bikaner & Jaipur, Branch Mandi Gobindgarh Vs. Ramesh Kaur and others to the learned District Judge, Ludhiana at an early date and in any case within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Learned District Judge, Ludhiana is also directed to assign the case to the learned Court of competent jurisdiction at Khanna and preferably to the same Court who is trying the other identical civil suits pending between the same parties, for their early decision, in accordance with law.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present application stands disposed of.
