This is a petition under section 24 CPC for transfer proceedings of civil suit, filed by the respondent for declaration with consequential relief of permanent injunction, pending at Karnal to Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a petition under section 125 Cr.P.C. filed by the applicant is already pending at Kurukshetra and the respondent as a counter blast has filed a suit for declaration with consequential relief of permanent injunction at Karnal, with the allegation that he was minor at the time of marriage. Thus, proceedings of the said suit be also transferred to a court of coordinate jurisdiction at Kurukshetra.

I do not find any merit in the petition. The suit was filed at Karnal as parties lastly resided together at village Jamalpur, District Karnal. Moreover, distance from Kurukshetra to Karnal is hardly 35 kilometers. No ground to transfer the proceedings is made out.

Dismissed.
