This is a petition seeking transfer of proceedings initiated by husband-respondent under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, (for short 'the Act') from the court at Sonapat to Hisar.

It is urged before the court that certain litigation is already pending at Hisar. Applicant-wife is dependent upon her parents. Besides, the distance between the two places is about 160 Kms. Thus, it would be difficult for the applicant-wife to effectively defend the proceedings at Sonapat.

Respondent remains unrepresented despite service.

Keeping in view facts and circumstances of the case, it is directed that proceedings under Section 9 of the Act at Sonapat be transferred to a court of co-ordinate jurisdiction at Hisar.

The petition is allowed in these terms.
