Rajan Gupta, J.

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Petitioner, who is wife of respondent, seeks transfer of proceedings under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short 'the Act'), pending at Sonapat to Rewari. It is urged before the court that certain litigation are pending at Rewari. Petitioner is residing with her parents. She has no source of income and it is very difficult for her to defend the case at Sonapat as the distance from Sonapat to Rewari is 150 KMs.

Respondent remains un-represented despite service.

Keeping in view facts and circumstances of the case, it is directed that the proceedings under Section 13 of the Act pending at Sonapat be transferred to competent court at Rewari.
