This is a petition under section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure for transfer of proceedings from the Family Court at Barnala to the court of coordinate jurisdiction at Moga.

This court had sought a report from the court below about the stage of proceedings. It is evident that trial has made some headway. Respondent-husband has already led his evidence. The case is now at the stage of defendant's evidence. Under the circumstances, no ground for transfer of the case to Moga is made out. Distance between the two places is about 80/90 kilometers.

Dismissed.

On the date(s) petitioner's appearance is necessary before the trial court, the respondent-husband shall be liable to compensate her for travelling. He shall be liable to pay Rs.2000/- on each such date of hearing.
