Reply by way of affidavit on behalf of respondent is filed in court. Same is taken on record.

Prayer is for transfer of proceedings under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 instituted by respondent from the court at Patiala to Fatehgarh Sahib.

It is urged before the court that petitioner being a lady and resident of Fategarh Sahib, it is difficult for her to defend the proceeding pending at Patiala.

Said prayer has been opposed by learned counsel representing the respondent. According to him minor child is in the custody of respondent and distance between Fatehgarh Sahib (Village Bhatmajra P.S. Sirhind) to Patiala is nor more than 35-40 KMs. Almost, same distance respondent would have to cover to appear before the court at Fatehgarh Sahib.

Keeping in view above said facts and circumstances, I find no ground to transfer the proceedings. Trial has already made some headway. Petitioner may not be required to appear before the trial court except on one or two dates to depose as a witness. On the date petitioner appears before the trial court, respondent shall pay ₹ 2,000/- as litigation/travelling expenses.

Disposed of as above.
