By these two transfer applications filed on behalf of the applicant-wife, two litigations filed by the respondent-husband are being sought to be transferred from Hisar to Amritsar.

Affidavit on behalf of the respondent in compliance of the order dated 15.03.2016 filed in the Court today, is taken on record and copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the applicant.

During the course of hearing, applicant-wife and respondent-husband, who are present in the Court, have agreed for transfer of both these litigations from Hisar to Bathinda instead of Amritsar. In this view of the matter, instant consent order is being passed for transferring both the litigations from Hisar to Bathinda.

Accordingly, learned District Judge, Hisar is directed to send the complete record of case No.17-C dated 04.04.2015 filed by the respondent-husband, which is a suit for permanent injunction, to the learned District Judge, Bathinda. Similarly, learned District Judge, Hisar is directed to send the complete record of case No.23-Guard, which is stated to be a petition under Section 25 of the Guardians and Wards Act, 1890, seeking custody of the child, to the learned District Judge, Bathinda. Let record of both these cases be sent by the learned District Judge, Hisar to the learned District Judge, Bathinda at an early date and in any case within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Learned District Judge, Bathinda is also directed to assign both

the abovesaid cases to the learned Courts of competent jurisdiction for their early decision, in accordance with law.

Parties are directed to appear before the learned District Judge, Bathinda on 08.07.2016.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, both these transfer applications stand disposed of, however, with no order as to costs.
