PARAMJEET SINGH DHALIWAL, J. (ORAL)

Instant petition under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure has been filed seeking transfer of petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act (for short 'the Act') titled '**Satwinder Singh Vs. Rajinder Kaur**', filed by respondent-husband from the Court at Patiala to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Ferozepur.

Parties are present in person. They state that there is no possibility of amicable settlement between them.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

Learned counsel for the applicant contended that respondent has filed a petition under Section 13 of the Act, which is pending in the

Court of learned Additional District Judge, Patiala. Now applicant is residing with her parents and minor son at Ferozepur. It is further contended that distance between Patiala and Ferozepur is 200 k.m.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondent does not oppose the application, however requests that the petition under Section 13 of the Act may be transferred to Faridkot, which is in between Patiala and Ferozepur and it will be convenient for both the parties to attend proceedings there.

Learned counsel for the applicant states that the applicant has no objection if the petition under Section 13 of the Act is transferred to Faridkot.

In view of consent of both the sides, petition under Section 13 of the Act pending in the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Patiala is withdrawn and ordered to be transferred to learned District Judge, Faridkot, who may assign the same to the Court of competent jurisdiction there. Learned District Judge, Patiala, shall ensure that entire record of the case is sent to learned District Judge, Faridkot. The parties are directed to appear before the learned District Judge, Faridkot on 23.02.2016.
