This is an application for transfer of the HMA case from Karnal to Panipat.

After arguing for some time, counsel for the applicant states that the applicant would not press this application for transfer in case the respondent-husband pays her necessary transport charges for every date when she has to go from Panipat to Karnal, apart from whatever maintenance she may be entitled in law.

Counsel for the respondent states that he would not oppose the prayer for reasonable expenses.

In the circumstances, it is directed that for every time the applicant has to go to Karnal from Panipat to attend the hearing, the respondent would pay her ₹ 500/-.

This application stands disposed of.
