Applicant, by way of instant application under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, seeks transfer of a petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 filed by the respondent-husband from Gurgaon to Chandigarh.

Notice of motion was issued and further proceedings before the learned trial Court were stayed.

However, when the case was taken up for hearing on 30.11.2015, none came present and in the interest of justice, case was adjourned for today. Similar is the position today. Case has been called twice. Neither anybody has come present nor any request for pass over has been made. It seems that applicant is no more interested in pursuing the instant transfer application.
