Instant application under Section 24 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure has been filed seeking transfer of petition, under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act (hereinafter referred to as the “Act”), titled “Jagdish Vs. Ritu Sharma”, filed by respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage, from Panipat to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the applicant contends that respondent-husband filed a petition under Section 13 of the Act, which is pending before the learned Addl. District Judge, Panipat. Petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. and petition under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, filed by the applicant, are pending against the respondent at Jagadhri. Learned counsel for the applicant further states that

petition under Section 13 of the Act may be transferred to Jagadhri and it will be convenient for both the parties to attend the proceedings there.

Learned counsel for the respondent states that he has no objection if the petition under Section 13 of the Act is transferred to Jagadhri.

In view of consent of both the parties, petition under Section 13 of the Act, titled “Jagdish vs. Ritu Sharma”, pending in the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Panipat is ordered to be withdrawn and transferred to learned District Judge, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri, who may assign the same to the court of competent jurisdiction there. Learned Additional District Judge, Panipat shall ensure that entire record of the case is sent to the learned District Judge, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri. The parties are directed to appear before the learned District Judge, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri on 21.03.2016.

Disposed of accordingly.
