Instant application under Section 24 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure has been filed seeking transfer of petition, under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act (hereinafter referred to as the “Act”) titled “Anubhav Kumar vs. Gitu Gupta @ Geetanjli”, filed by respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage, from Patiala to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Panchkula.

Learned counsel for the applicant states that petition under Section 13 of the Act may be transferred to Panchkula, as it will be convenient for both the parties to attend the proceedings there.

Learned counsel for the respondent, after seeking instructions from Mr. Anubhav Kumar, states that he has no objection if the petition under Section 13 of the Act is transferred to Panchkula.

In view of consent of both the parties, petition under Section 13 of the Act, pending in the Family Court, Patiala is ordered to be withdrawn and transferred to learned District Judge, Panchkula, who may assign the same to the court of competent jurisdiction there. The Family Court, Patiala shall ensure that entire record of the case is sent to the learned District Judge, Panchkula. Learned District Judge, Panchkula shall ensure that petition under Section 13 of the Act is decided preferably within six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. The parties are directed to appear before the learned District Judge, Panchkula on 02.04.2016.

Disposed of accordingly.
