Learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that the matter has been settled between the parties by way of settlement/compromise dated 22.04.2016 before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. They further submit that both the parties shall remain bound by the terms and conditions of settlement/compromise dated 22.04.2016, which may be treated as integral part of the order passed in the instant transfer application. Parties are also present. Applicant as well as respondent undertake to withdraw their respective litigations pending against each other, at the earliest possible time.

In view of the abovesaid common stand taken on behalf of both the parties, instant transfer application has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of, as such.

However, it is made clear that the settlement/compromise dated 22.04.2016 arrived at between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court shall make part of the instant order.
